In case the length of the review procedure exceeds the period of five years, the relevant data are kept for the duration of the ongoing review procedure.  3) Data of jury members: the personal data of the jury members is retained for a period of <i>five years</i> from the date of the award decision for the EIT Awards 2024 and for the EIT Women Leadership Award procedure.
		4) Data of KIC SPOCs: the personal data for the KIC SPOCs is retained for a period of <i>five years</i> following the termination of their task as KIC SPOCs.
